The temperature during the day is on average around +18°C to +25°C, and at night: +10°C to +15°C. Rain is also possible. We recommend that you also include a sweater, a light windbreaker and a raincoat in your wardrobe.

Money

Latvia is in the euro zone and here you can pay with euro banknotes. ATM will be available.
